



Carrier Grade NAT (CGN)

The GoNetspeed network is designed using Carrier Grade NAT (CGN). CGN was developed in order to conserve IPV4 address space and allow several home users to share a single IPV4 address. The vast majority of Internet users are not be affected by the use of CGN.

Users requiring inbound Internet access for applications like web-hosting, email hosting, PLEX hosting, etc. will however be affected by CGN.

Users needing inbound access will be required to lease a public IPV4 address from GoNetspeed.
